Educational Textbooks for the Visually Impaired OverDrive is the exclusive provider of digital content protection, management, and storage for the National Instructional Materials Access Center (NIMAC). Established in 2004, NIMAC serves as a repository for electronic files from educational publishers. These files can be used by school systems to produce materials for individuals with print disabilities. More than 21,000 core curriculum titles from nearly 100 publishers are protected and stored, waiting to be turned into accessible Braille, audio, or large-print versions of the text. www.NIMAC.us



Supporting the EPUB Standard For visually impaired users, the EPUB standard for eBooks and digital publications contains support for accessibility features. The EPUB format is compatible with the Digital Accessibility Information System (DAISY) DTBook standard. OverDrive, along with other major technology and publishing companies, fully supports this format. www.idpf.org

A librarian's guide to digital book accessibility



What is OverDrive LEAP?

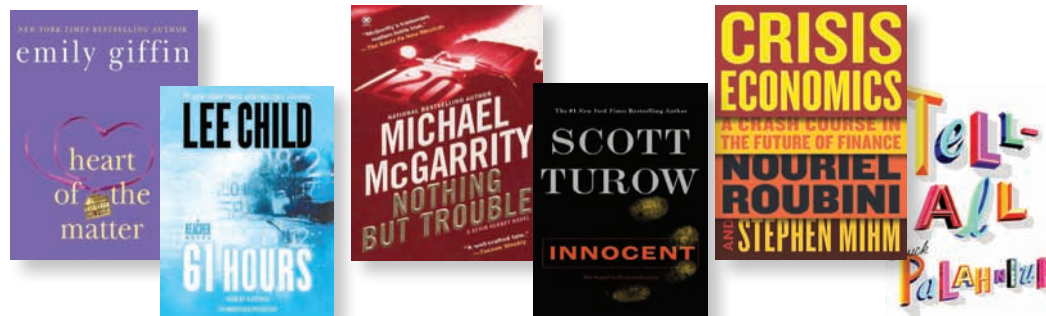
OverDrive LEAP, Library eBook Accessibility Program, provides print-disabled patrons with access to print materials in digital formats. Qualified patrons can download up to 20 accessible eBooks every month for a full year--at no cost to libraries and at no cost to patrons.

Who is involved?

LEAP is the result of a partnership between OverDrive and Bookshare (www.bookshare.org), a non-profit agency that provides timely eBook access to individuals with print disabilities. As part of OverDrive's ongoing commitment to accessibility, OverDrive will fully fund a one-year membership to Bookshare for qualifying patrons. This free membership will provide accessible eBooks to library patrons with print disabilities at US public libraries with an OverDrive-powered eBook collection.

What books are available?

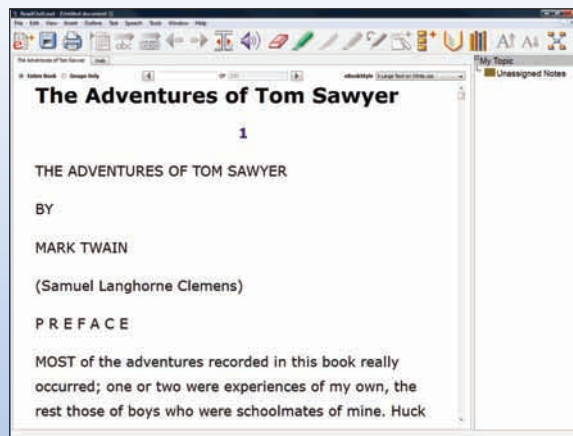
Bookshare hosts more than 70,000 popular digital books, textbooks, newspapers, and magazines. The Bookshare catalog is growing each month, accumulating thousands of new titles. While Bookshare's collection is not identical to the eBook collection that OverDrive supplies to your library, print-disabled patrons will have full access to Bookshare's extensive catalog of titles in a variety of subjects.



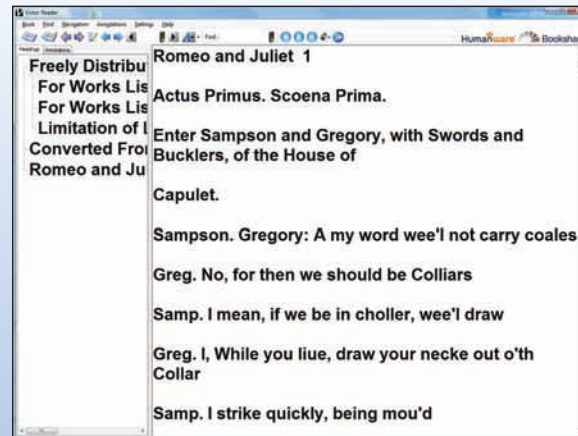
Sample titles available from Bookshare at LEAP

What formats are available?

Digital books from Bookshare are available in accessible formats such as DAISY and can be used with a variety of accessible devices. In addition, a variety of free desktop software is compatible with eBooks from Bookshare, including Read: OutLoud and Victor Reader (samples below).



Read: OutLoud (Free desktop software)



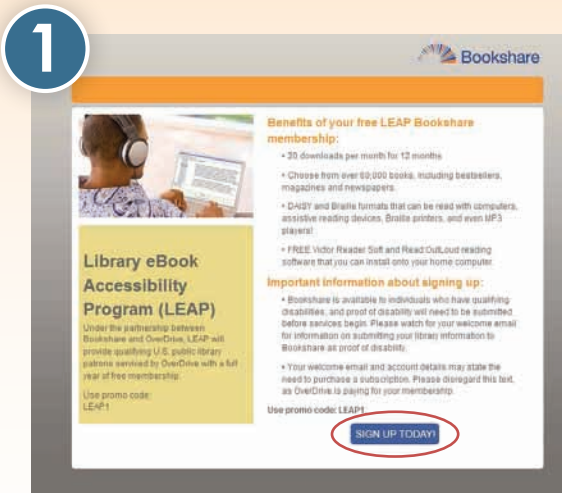

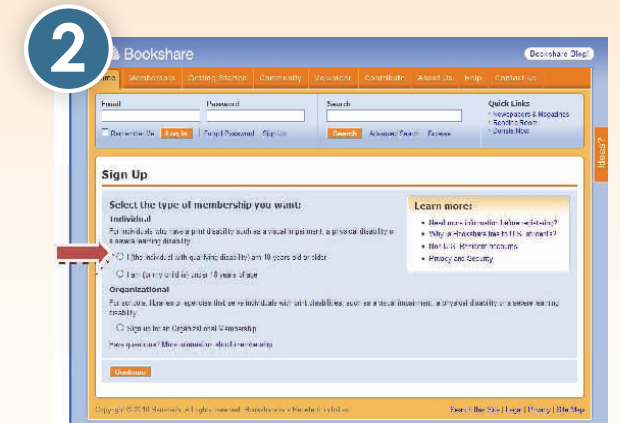

How does LEAP work?

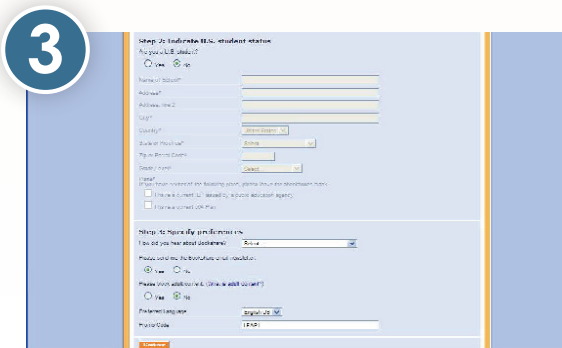
Libraries with an OverDrive-powered eBook collection can simply contact us and ask to add LEAP. We'll update your OverDrive-hosted website with a link and accessible webpage where patrons can register. Once the LEAP information is posted, your patron can sign up in six easy steps:



User will navigate to this landing page from the library's 'Virtual Branch' website and select the 'sign up today' link.



User selects 'over 18 years of age' registration.



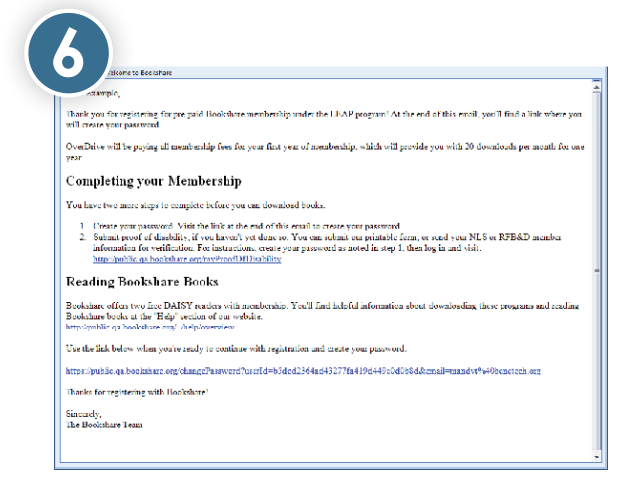
User submits registration details...
