The Ohio eBook Project provides access to thousands of eBooks, audiobooks, music titles and videos. All you need is a library card from the State Library of Ohio, or any Ohio eBook Project member library, and a personal computer or laptop to get started finding these great materials.

Devices

Ohio eBook Project materials can be used on many mobile devices, audio devices and eReaders.* To see if your device is compatible with the service and the compatible formats for your device please visit <http://overdrive.com/Resources/DRC/Default.aspx>.



*You may need a personal computer or laptop to checkout and/or transfer materials.

Find & Checkout Materials

Browse or search for items in the formats appropriate for your device or computer (see "Devices" above for more information) at the Ohio eBook Project website: <http://ohdbks.lib.overdrive.com>

Add items to your cart, and when you are ready to checkout "Proceed to Check out." Select your lending period and "Confirm Check out."

Depending on the type of device or computer you have, follow the appropriate instructions on downloading, transferring and using your materials.

If a title is checked out by another patron you will need to place a hold on that item. Join the waiting list by entering your email address. You will receive an email when your item is available to check out.

eBooks

Unless you are using a Kindle™ eReader and Kindle™ Books, you will need to install free software to your computer to access and transfer your eBooks (EPUB and PDF formats) to compatible devices. Download and install the free Adobe Digital Editions software from: <http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions>.

Authorize

Once the Adobe Digital Editions software is installed it will ask you to authorize your computer. You can proceed without authorizing your computer but you will then be unable to use any of your library eBook titles on other computers or devices.

1. Open Adobe Digital Editions; the "Setup Assistant" dialog box is displayed.
2. Click "Continue" and the "Activation" screen is displayed.
3. Under "Authorize Computer" enter the email address and password for your Adobe ID.



If you do not have an Adobe ID, click the "get an Adobe ID online" link.

- Follow the instructions to sign up for an Adobe ID.
- Return to the Activation screen.
- Enter the email address and password for your Adobe account.

4. Click "Activate."
5. Click "Finish" to close the "Setup Assistant" dialog box.

Download and Use Materials

Once the Adobe Digital Editions software is installed and authorized, download your eBooks from the Ohio eBook Project website. Open the file in Adobe Digital Editions and you can now read and enjoy the title on your computer, or transfer it to your compatible eReader.

Transfer

With Adobe Digital Editions open, connect your eBook Reader to your computer. Follow the prompts to authorize your device; make sure you use the same Adobe ID as entered in the "Authorize" step. When complete, your device should appear under "Bookshelves" in Adobe Digital Editions.

- Drag and drop eBook titles to your eBook Reader.

- Once the transfer is complete, eject your device and disconnect.

Mobile Devices

If you will be using a device compatible with the OverDrive Media Console Mobile App, you do not need a computer or laptop to transfer materials. See the Compatible Device page to determine if your device is compatible with the OverDrive Media Console Mobile App: <http://overdrive.com/Resources/DRC/Default.aspx>

Download the OverDrive Media Console App from your device's App store. Open the App and authorize with your Adobe ID (see Authorize for more information about Adobe IDs.) Tap "Get Books +" and then "Add a Library +." Search for your library by name, city or zip code. Tap on your library's name, then tap the star to add Ohio eBook Project to your favorites, then tap the Ohio eBook Project name to open the Mobile Website.

Log into the mobile site and then browse or search for items. Add items to your cart, then proceed to checkout. Once your items are checked out tap "Download" to download them to the OverDrive Media Console App for use.

Kindle™ books

Find & Checkout Materials



Search or browse for a Kindle compatible title to checkout and download at <http://ohdbks.lib.overdrive.com>.

Once your Kindle Books are checked out, click "Get for Kindle" for each title.

Your browser will open to the Amazon.com website. If you are not already logged in you will be prompted to log

in or create an Amazon account.

From the Kindle Book Loan page, select where you would like your title delivered and "Get library book."

The next page will further instruct you on how to access your library Kindle Book to read depending on where you chose for it to be delivered.

Transferring via USB

An active Wi-Fi connection is required for wireless delivery to a Kindle device. If your Kindle is not Wi-Fi capable or you do not have an active Wi-Fi connection, you will need to transfer titles via USB. *Library Kindle Books cannot be transferred via 3G connections.*

1. After downloading, use your USB cable to connect your computer and Kindle.
2. Your Kindle will appear as a drive on your computer.
3. Copy your downloaded file from your computer to your Kindle's documents folder.

Kindle Reading Apps

If you do not have a Kindle device you can still use Kindle Books on your Windows PC, Mac computer, iPhone, iPad, BlackBerry, Android or Windows Phone 7 with the Kindle for PC reading app. Once the software is installed, register it with your Amazon account and it will begin syncing titles borrowed or purchased with your Amazon account.

Kindle Reading Apps are available at Amazon.com in the Kindle Store under Free Kindle Reading Apps.

Audiobooks

Install

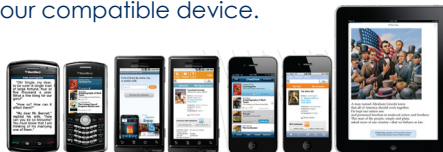
Follow the **Find and Checkout** instructions (inside) to locate titles appropriate for your computer or compatible device.

Before downloading, using and transferring audiobook titles for the first time, you will need to install the free OverDrive Media Console software to your computer: <http://overdrive.com/Software/omc/>.

Once installed you may need to perform a Windows Media Player Security Upgrade at <http://ohdbks.lib.overdrive.com/>.

Download

Download your audiobook files from the Ohio eBook Project and open them with OverDrive Media Console. You may now listen to and enjoy the title on your computer or continue to transfer it to your compatible device.



Transfer

You can transfer audiobook titles to compatible devices using OverDrive Media Console. With your device plugged in and a title downloaded to your computer, highlight the title, then click the "Transfer" button at the top of the software. Follow the steps to complete the transfer of your audiobook.

If you are transferring to an Apple device, you will need to have iTunes® open in the background to complete the transfer.

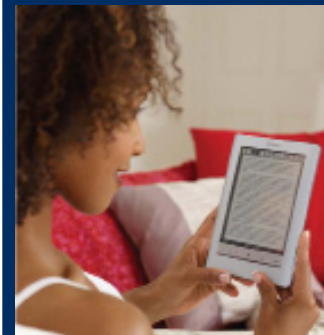
