by Rodney P. Carlisle

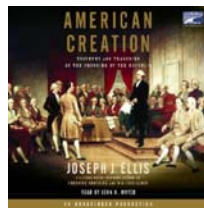

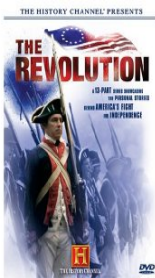
American Creation by Joseph Ellis Book on CD

Collectors are waking up today to the new growing value of American memorabilia, often the symbolism of all these objects speaking louder than the objects themselves.

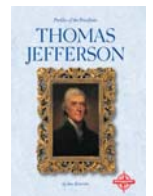
