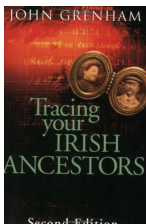

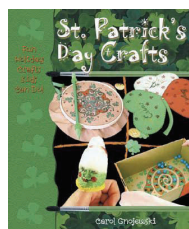
Tracing Your Irish Ancestors: The Complete Guide

St. Patrick's Day Crafts

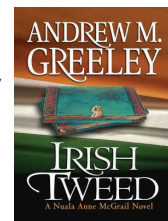

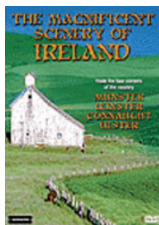
Irish Tweed by Andrew M. Greeley

Spirit of the Irish by The Dubliners

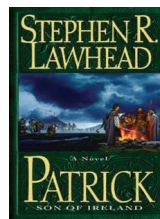
