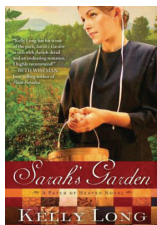

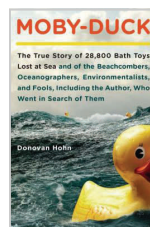
notorious for fleeing a battle in which several English gentlemen lost their lives. What they don't know, though, is that Samuel is in London because of this massacre...
