## SAVE FEDERAL FUNDING FOR OHIO LIBRARIES

The State Library of Ohio funds many of the state and local library services represented on this map using Library Services and Technology Act funds (\$5 million annually) from the Institute of Museum and Library Services. This includes supporting the research materials in the Ohio Web Library with \$1.6 million each year and providing the patrons of 177 Ohio public libraries with eBooks using approximately \$500,000 each year to purchase content and pay associated hosting fees. The federal budget proposes eliminating this source of critical funding for libraries.
