Dayton Metro Libraries

Dayton Metro Libraries launched their Career Adventures Camp, an intensive day camp experience that provides career awareness knowledge and skill development for middle school students. 30 students learned about local businesses, careers that in high-demand, and library resources, programs and materials the students could use in the years to come.

Archdiocese of Cincinnati Archives

The Archdiocese of Cincinnati Archives digitized copies of their diocesan newspaper, The Catholic Telegraph, for the years 1845-1870. By completing this project, their online collection now contains the years 1831 (the year the publication began) through 1885. Ultimately, the Archdiocese of Cincinnati Archives hopes to digitize the entire publication (through 2013).

Perry Local Schools (Massillon)

A Reader's Theatre (in digital form) was created by 6th grade students via iPads to recreate stories that students read. Students collaborated together to learn how to use iMovie and Do-Ink to create a storyboard to share; they were then able to use a green screen to create digital backdrops to correlate with their story. Students also learned editing software for their videos. Students were very creative and enjoyed collaborating together to create their own stories. Everyone enjoyed the final results of the Reader's Theatre! by sharing their video with the other 6th grade classes.
