

To log in as a state employee, click the State of Ohio Employees tab, then click the database you want to view.



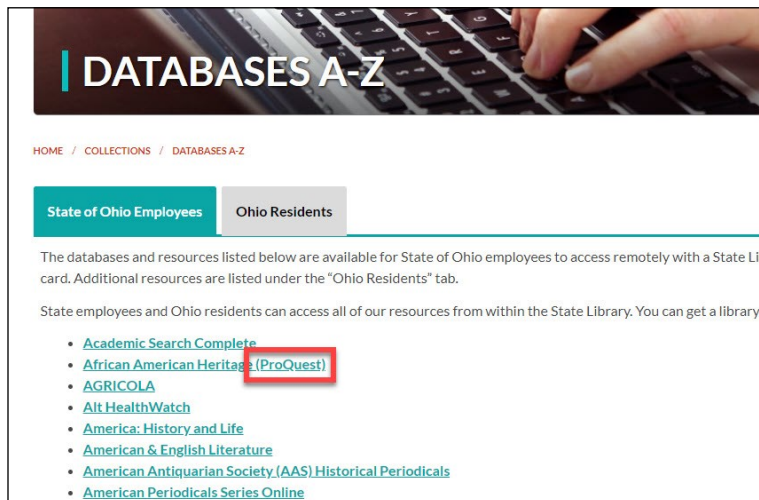
